These books are available in many libraries and book stores.

- Read a minimum of four other grade appropriate novels. Similar level books and books from higher grade levels may be chosen by students with parent's approval.
- Students are to keep a record of books that are read during the summer. Forms are available in the main office. Each reading entry needs to be signed by the parents. Forms are to be brought to the fourth grade teacher the first week of school.

It may be beneficial to read the required text closer to the start of the school year so that the material is fresh in the student's mind when school begins.

Reading is such an important part of life. With it we can learn God's truth in His Word. We can also explore the world without ever leaving the house.
