

Summer Reading Requirements for incoming 2nd graders

- Read a minimum of four books, choosing from various genres and authors. Comparable level books and books from higher grade levels may be chosen by students with parent's approval.
- Students are to keep a record of books that are read during the summer. Forms are available at the main office. Each reading entry needs to be initialed by a parent. Forms are to be brought to the child's teacher the first week of school.

Please keep in mind that this book list is only a suggestion. Students may substitute books which are not on the list, or choose from books on an upper grade level's list.

Books should be read independently by the student.
