- Complete the contract indicating that you have read the book of your choice. *The student and parent must sign the contract.* By signing the contract, parents are approving their child's selection for the book of their choice.
- 4. Turn in the contract and on the first day of school. Your t-shirt and oral report need to be prepared before the first day of school. Presentation days for oral book reports will be assigned during the first week of school. There will be a 10% grade reduction in the grade for each day the assignment is late.

- 8. Setting
- 9. One-sentence statement about the book's main theme (or idea)
- 10. Favorite quote or saying
- 11. Pictures
- 12. Your recommendation
- 13. Color
- 14. Your Name
- -- Use the front and back of the shirt.
- -- Except for the statement about the book's main theme and your favorite quote, you do not need to use complete sentences.
- -- You may use markers, paint, iron-on, sew-on items, etc.
- -- Quality and creativity count!

### **Oral Book Report Instructions**

While wearing your t-shirt, you will give an oral report on your book.

#### You must talk about the following things:

- (1) Give the book title and author.
- (2) Talk about the main characters in the book.
- (3) Explain the setting of the book.
- (4) Explain the rising action
- (5) Discuss the conflict (man vs. man, man vs. nature, etc.)
- (4) Explain the main theme of the book (without giving away the ending).
- (5) Tell the class your favorite quote or saying from the book. Explain why it is your favorite.
- (6) Explain how the pictures on your t-shirt relate to the book.
- (7) Do you recommend the book to the class? Why or why not?
- -- You will be graded on how clearly you speak and your eye contact with the class.
- -- Make sure you practice before you share your t-shirt and oral report in class.
